Project description:

The project aims to strengthen Moldova's justice sector via the provision of both analytical outputs (thematic reviews and policy recommendations) and capacity-building activities aimed at staff of the Ministry of Justice and other institutions concerned by ongoing reforms in the justice sector. In particular, the OECD will carry out an OECD justice review, including a functional review of the Ministry of Justice, and an evaluation of the justice sector strategy.

Expected results:

1. Key Moldovan stakeholders are better able to implement their modernisation agenda and formulating a national consensus on which to strengthen independence and impartiality of the justice system in the long term
2. Strategic leadership, management and performance for a transparent and responsive justice system are enhanced
3. Access to justice for all targeting specific vulnerabilities is enhanced
4. Justice system's capacity to respond to Moldova's legal and justice needs is increased
5. Key Moldovan stakeholders have a solid understanding of the level of implementation and impact of the strategy
6. The Ministry of Justice's capacity to evaluate the impact of justice sector policies is enhanced
