Project description:

The Gagauzian Modernisation Convention (GaMCon) aims to strengthen civil society participation in policymaking, enhance cooperation between ATU Gagauzia and Moldova's central government, and support local development initiatives. The project provides a structured platform for policy dialogue through the GaMCon Debate Forum, engages youth in governance through the Gagauzian Young Leaders Program (GYLP), and funds community-driven projects via the Local Development Support Program. These initiatives foster collaboration among key stakeholders, promote democratic governance, and contribute to the modernisation of Gagauzia.

Expected results:

- 1. Improved cooperation and integration between ATU Gagauzia and Moldova's central government in regional development planning.
- 2. Increased youth engagement in civic and political processes, with young leaders contributing to governance and community initiatives.
