Project description

The Joint European Union and Council of Europe Project “Promoting Media Freedom and Pluralism in the Republic of Moldova ” is aimed to strengthen or establish legal and institutional guarantees for a pluralistic media landscape in the Republic of Moldova.

Expected results:

- The first ever working group mandated to align the Moldovan media legislation with European standards and for providing expert assistance in drafting the new Audiovisual Code and the first ever Media Development Strategy. (The Audiovisual Code was adopted by the Moldovan Parliament)
- A training centre at the public-service broadcaster Teleradio-Moldova which will provide crucial support in setting up the documentary films department Telefilm-Chisinau as a centre of journalistic excellence aimed at enhancing the quality of Teleradio-Moldova video productions and ensuring content diversification.
- In Gagauzia, to be provided support to the regional public broadcaster in setting up the Multimedia unit and in drafting the company's development strategy for the next five years.
