Erasmus+

Objectives:

Erasmus+ aims to become more inclusive, digital and greener and it will support the resilience of the education process under pandemic conditions.



Achievements of Erasmus + Programme 2014-2020 in Moldova:

- 21 Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE) projects;
- **22** Jean Monnet projects;
- over 600 ICM projects (International Credit Mobility);
- over 3600 Erasmus + academic mobilities for students and university professors between universities of the Republic of Moldova and of the EU;
- 30 scholarships were awarded to Moldovan beneficiaries within the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree projects;
- EU funding enabled 1842 students and academic staff from Moldova to study and teach in the EU;
- > 29 Moldovan Master's students were granted full Erasmus scholarships;
- More than 4 331 Moldovan young people and youth workers took part in Erasmus+ exchanges.

The purpose:

The aim of the Young European Ambassadors initiative is to raise awareness of the EU cooperation in the region, to contribute to the development of youth policies and to work together for a better future.

The Young European Ambassadors Initiative was set up in 2016 and is growing every year, now reaching over 650 young people, representing over 30 different nationalities. The Republic of Moldova is represented by over 80 young people, their number being almost double compared to last year.

EU4YOUTH

Objectives:

The EU4Youth project fosters the active participation of young people in the society and their employability, by developing youth leadership and entrepreneurship through a variety of actions, including capacity building, fellowships, support to policy dialogue, as well as through providing grants to active organizations in these areas.

EU4YOUTH: School Garden for the development of agricultural entrepreneurship

The purpose:

To foster the employability and the active participation of young people residing in disadvantaged rural areas in the society and in the economy by developing modern labour skills, supporting them towards becoming leaders/entrepreneurs and promoting new professional opportunities among them.



During the period 2018-2021, the following results were achieved:

- 800 students engaged in gardening activities;
- 1400 students in educational institutions were involved in:
 - learning subjects (biology, technological education, optional specialized classes).
 - Iocal fairs, educational events related to business development, entrepreneurship, healthy lifestyle, proper nutrition.
 - 800 students and young people participated in study visits;
- 13 dedicated events conducted;
- 4 production incubators organized study visits within the School Garden Project;
- Participation in 6 national larmarEco fairs and 15 local ones;
- Income for the entire period of the project \$ 6950.

EU4YOUTH:

Unlocking the potential of young social entrepreneurs in Moldova and Ukraine

The purpose:

The project helps to foster the social entrepreneurial potential of young people in the Republic of Moldova and Ukraine by establishing a favourable ecosystem for social enterprises, as well as by inspiring and supporting more young social entrepreneurs to develop and sustain their innovative solutions for promoting the social inclusion and the environmental sustainability across both countries.



The main results achieved in 2021:

- 47 individual consultations for social entrepreneurs and potential social entrepreneurs;
- 2 information sessions on obtaining the status of social enterprise;
- 20 young people trained in developing social business plans;
- 30 young social entrepreneurs in the Moldovan-Ukrainian regional network of social entrepreneurs;
- **5 social businesses** launched by young people
- (10,000 euros per start-up, a total of 50,000 euros awarded);
- 2 national information and awareness campaigns on social entrepreneurship;
- Over 500,000 people informed and sensitized.

"Support to vocational education and training (vet) in the field of green economy" project

Objectives:

The overall objective of the project is to develop a consolidated, demandoriented dual VET system aiming at the promotion of ecological, economic and social development in the Republic of Moldova. The target groups covered by the project include mainly young people who intend to continue their secondary and post-secondary non-tertiary education through the dual VET model.



Results achieved:

- Over the past 6 years of project implementation, more than 5 200 students (55% boys and 45% girls) were involved in 66 dual VET programmes within 44 VET institutions and almost 280 companies and public institutions.
- As a result, 71% of the dual VET graduates were employed within 6 months after graduation, of which 43% are employed in industries, 23% - in services, 12% - in education, while 25% of graduates have followed their education in other institutions, including tertiary education at the university.
- The transition from the education to the employment period occurred immediately in 55% of cases, in 28% of cases – within 0–3 months after graduation, and in 8% of cases – within 3–6 months after graduation.

Capacity building for efficient quality development in vocational education and training and inclusive education is among such priority areas.

Re-Engineering Vocational Orientation and Career Counselling (REVOCC) for Moldovan labour force competitiveness

Impact:

The career choices of young Moldovans are based on labour market needs and result in increased employment and enhanced labour productivity in the national economy.



Results achieved:



young people are accessing career guidance from ANOFM and VET institutions through the Career Guidance system set up for this purpose.



VET teachers trained and certified in teaching the "Personal Development and Career Planning" module to their students, gender-disaggregated



young women trained in leadership for entrepreneurship to attenuate the gender disparities in selfemployment/start-ups

Develop life skills and healthy behaviours in students of Vocational Education & Training aiming at their development and job readiness

Impact:

VET students, particularly girls, have more opportunities for decent employment and a reduced transition time to labour market by building their life skills and being empowered to practice safe and healthy behaviours.



Main project achievements:

2085

VET students (650 boys and 1435 girls, out of which 15 young people with disabilities) have been trained on healthy behaviours through 105 peer-to-peer education activities, including 12 creative events. In total, since September 2020, 2 327 boys and girls from VET institutions were provided peer education on gender-based violence prevention, safe relationships, sexual and reproductive health, and rights. 12

VET institutions were equipped with modern learning spaces suitable for students with disabilities and different learning capacities and students from ethnic minority groups.

Objectives:

The Support to Confidence Building Measures Programme aims to increase trust between people on both sides of the Nistru river by supporting joint activities in four core areas:

- EU support to economic development and entrepreneurship,
- EU assistance for community development and cross-river civil society organizations sectoral platforms,
- EU cultural and historical heritage support,
- EU support to cooperative local media content development.

Better opportunities for Young Women and Men Not in Education, Employment and Training in Moldova (NEET Inclusion Initiative)

Objectives:

The overall objective of the project is to contribute to better social inclusion and empowerment of NEET (not in education, employment or training) young women and men in Moldova through civil society engagement.



Results achieved:

- More than 50 CSOs were reached and informed about different issues related to NEET youth sector;
- 28 CSOs were selected to engage in NEET policy advocacy;
- 19 youth organizations were supported by consolidating and strengthening their analytical capacities, developing skills for promoting NEET youth initiatives;
- 21 CSOs increased their organizational capacities to monitor services for NEET youth;
- 15 local CSOs received grants.
- 5 regional youth-led entrepreneurship funds are supported in developing and sustaining their own fund;
- Support for **at least 50** entrepreneurship ideas of young men and women.

EU4MOLDOVA: Startup city Cahul

Objectives:

The project aims to contribute to covering the digital gap between the capital city and the south of the country and it will ensure an equitable economic development among the regions of the Republic of Moldova.



Results of the Educational Programmes in the first year of Project Implementation:

- Tekwill in Every School
 Out of a total of 117 schools, 34 are
 already included in the programme,
 with a number of 73 teachers.

 Furthermore, 21 schools and 60
 teachers were selected, based on
 the established criteria.
- 2. 9 digital labs in schools of the region (Cahul, Cantemir, Leova and Taraclia)
- 3. ICT4Women programme Online tech skills training for 50 women, out of which 30 participants graduated.
- 4. Robotics & Programming courses 4 courses were launched. A total number of 71 children participate in the programme.

 graduates;
 ICT4Youth career orientation sessions
 – 300 beneficiaries.
