• Twinning project ENI/2020/416-630 (EC) Improving Spatial Data Services in the Republic of Moldova following EU standards (MD 16 ENI OT 01 19 (MD/35) aims to contribute to further development of National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) in the Republic of Moldova, based on EU INSPIRE Directive.

- 2: NSDI Cost Recovery Model developed
- 3: Use of the existing data within the NSDI enabled
- 4 - Capacity Building and Awareness

It will enable the Agency for Land Relations and Cadastre (ALRC) to assess constraints in managing geospatial data in a more efficient and sustainable way, and take corrective measures towards achieving this. As a final goal of this project, the National Spatial Data Infrastructure should be a functional tool for citizens, public institutions and economic operators in order to check relevant information regarding properties, infrastructures and environmental issues on any particular zone of the country.

Furthermore, NSDI will provide reliable tool to the authorities for better planning capabilities in a broad range of sectorial policies, namely transport, environment and agriculture among others.

The purpose was reached by:

- the foundation for establishment of NSDI in line with INSPIRE directive 2007/2/EC and the best international practices of management of geographical data;
- developing the capacity of ALRC both technical and administratively in one of their main task as national coordinator of NSDI;
- developing the capacity of ALRC and the stakeholders of the project both

technical and administratively in their task as providers of spatial data and – improving understanding of SDI and enhancing the co-operation between public authorities that participated in the project.

- officials from ALRC and the stakeholders of the project have been trained within the main components of NSDI;
- collaboration Agreement Regarding Implementation of the National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) has been drafted;
- concept of Business Model for ALRC (including its enterprises) and Fee Model for data sharing have been introduced;
- tool for development of network services has been developed and installed;
- cooperation Agreement Regarding Demonstration of SDI Solution in Pilot Area in Line with EU Best Practices has been drafted and signed;
- the role of ALRC in the NSDI society has been re-defined, a NSDI-coordination structure has been drawn and purposes and responsibilities by the different actors in the infrastructure have been defined and described;
- SDI solution for the pilot area has been demonstrated.
